**Rone**'s latest release is a new piece performed with the worldwide well-known classical orchestra **Les Siècles**, composed of 85 musi-

cians and conducted by François-Xavier Roth.

The frack "Motion" originally was intended to last only one minute and was used as the new theme of the bank **Société Générale** campaign. Its first release burst hundreds of requests and amplified the desire from the brand and the talented artist to make a real piece out of it.

The project then took on a new dimension and brought together Rone, the **Orchestre Les Siècles** and 19 amateur musicians who collaborated with the company, conducted by the conductor **François-Xavier Roth** and the pianist **Vanessa Wagner**. Together, they produced an electronic symphony of nearly 12 minutes.

For Rone, this was one of the biggest challenges of his still young career, testing his abilities on combining the strengths of classical music and the poetry of his electronic approach and sound.

To develop this new kind of "symphony", Rone was accompanied by the arranger **Romain Allender**, also known for his collaborations with Alexandre Desplat.

The entire production was arranged in collaboration with General POP (BETC).

The electronic symphony was recorded on March 18th, 2019 at Maison Alfort in the studios of the Orchestre National d'Ile de France, mixed by Cubenx in Berlin (Apparat studio) and mastered by Zino (Nils Frahm, Parcels).

The full EP, including the original 12-minute track and its 3 movements, will be released on Wednesday, May 15th on all platforms.

The profits raised by the title will be entirely donated to the "<u>Orchestre à l'Ecole</u>" association, which supports the development of orchestras in schools.
